



## COVID-19 Outdoor Facility Use

All group leaders and coaches (otherwise known as One Responsible Person - ORP's (or designate) are responsible for ensuring that their members observe regulations as follows:

All users must follow Province of Alberta and Alberta Health Services [Guidance on outdoor activities related to COVID-19](#), including:

- Physical distancing must ALWAYS be followed. Ensure participants are not within 2 meters (or 6 feet) of each other. Organizations, groups and those hosting outdoor recreation activities should refer to [alberta.ca/biz Guidance for Sport, Physical Activity and Recreation](#) for supports to help non-profits and businesses reopen safely.
- Each user group will be required to follow their provincial or national sport governing bodies guidelines related to COVID-19.
- Avoid using benches and touching any surfaces in the area if possible.

### Group Conduct

- Coaches and instructors are to reinforce message of social distancing guidelines. The ORP will be responsible for asking the COVID -19 screening questions to all participants attending and signing off with the CRCA that this will be completed each time your group rents the fields or diamonds.
- ORPS' must keep a log of everyone in attendance in their group with the date recorded to ensure contact tracing should an outbreak occur.
- Customers will be responsible for supplying their own PPE including masks and gloves (should they choose to wear them) and sanitizer for hands and equipment.

### Bookings

- The maximum number of individuals in a group outside is 100 people as per provincial orders; a group includes all persons related to the activity (coaches, assistants, volunteers, parents, spectators, etc.)
- There is a 15-minute buffer between bookings. Please do not arrive prior to 15 minutes before your booking. Groups must leave the field immediately after their booking time to reduce overlap of bookings and participants.
- Minimize time in and around the facility and in parking lots
- If entering the facility is necessary, please follow directional signage throughout.
- There are no indoor or outdoor washrooms or water fountains available at this time.

The CRCA will not have staff available onsite during bookings as the facility is closed until July. In an emergency please call local RCMP at 911.
